- Attract volunteer resources and support; and
- Provide leverage for generating other funds or resources.

The Berrien Community Foundation typically DOES NOT fund:

- Annual fundraising campaigns;
- Routine operating expenses;
- Religious or sectarian purposes;
- Political purposes;
- Existing obligations or debts/liabilities;
- Grants to individuals;
- Endowment funds;
- Efforts which will require a commitment for long-term financial support; and
- Travel for groups such as school classes, clubs or sports teams.

Low priority is given to capital campaigns.
